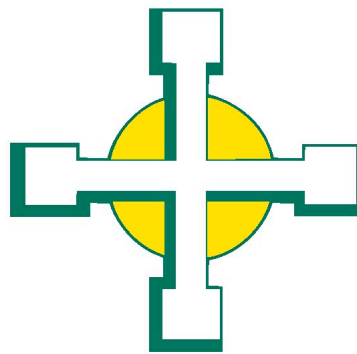

A Reading from the Letter of Paul to the Romans

5:1-5

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in hope of the glory of God.

Not only that, but we even boast of our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, and endurance, proven character, and proven character, hope.

NEW TESTAMENT READINGS**A Reading from the Letter of Paul to the Romans****5:5-11**

For Christ, while we were still helpless, yet died at the appointed time for the ungodly. Indeed, only with difficulty does one die for a just person, though perhaps for a good person one might even find courage to die. But God proves His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. How much more then, since we are not justified by His blood, will we be saved through him from the wrath. Indeed, if, while we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, how much more, once reconciled, will we be saved by His life. Not only that, but we also boast of God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

NEW TESTAMENT READINGS**A Reading from the Letter of Paul to the Romans****6:3-9**

Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life. For if we have grown into union with Him through a death like His, we shall also be united with Him in the resurrection. We know that our old self was crucified with Him, so that our sinful body might be done away with that we might no longer be in slavery in sin. For a dead person has been absolved from sin. If, then, we have died in Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over Him.

NEW TESTAMENT READINGS**A Reading from the Letter of Paul to the Romans 14:7-9, 10b-12**

None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then whether we live or die, we are the Lord's. For this is why Christ died and came to life, that He might be Lord of both the dead and the living. For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of God; for it is written:

“As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bend before me, and every tongue shall give praise to God.”

NEW TESTAMENT READINGS**A Reading from the First Letter of Paul to the Corinthians 12:31b-13:8a**

Be ambitious for higher gifts. And I am going to show you a way that is better than any of them. If I have all the eloquence of men or of angels, but speak without love, I am simply a gong booming or a cymbal crashing. If I have the gift of prophecy, understanding all the mysteries there are, and knowing everything, and if I have faith in all its fullness, to move mountains, but without love, then I am nothing at all. If I give away all that I possess, piece by piece, and if I even let them take my body to burn it, but am without love, it will do me no good whatever.

Love is always patient and kind; it is never jealous. Love is never boastful or conceited; it is never rude or selfish. It does not take offence, and is not resentful. Love takes no pleasure in other people's sins, but delights in the truth; it is always ready to excuse, to trust, to hope, and to endure whatever comes. Love does not come to an end.

NEW TESTAMENT READINGS**A Reading from the Second Letter of Paul to the Corinthians 4:14-5:1**
